

NOTICE

TO: VILLAGE OF GRESHAM DOG & CAT OWNERS

PURSUANT TO Ordinance # 12.08 notice is hereby given to all owners of dogs/cats in the Village of Gresham that rabies vaccinations and dog/cat licenses are required under the ordinance.

Vaccination by a veterinarian against rabies of all dogs/cats is required under (Ordinance #12.08) within 30 days after the dog/cat reaches 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Older vaccinated dogs/cat must be revaccinated when the certificates expires or within 3 years of the previous vaccination. Presentation of evidence that the dog/cat is currently immunized against rabies must be presented when obtaining dog/cat licenses.

All dogs/cats 5 months of age or older require a license. The minimum license fee for neutered males or spayed females is \$5.00 upon presentation or evidence attesting to the same and \$10.00 for the unneutered male or unsprayed female dog/cat, or one-half of these amounts if the dog becomes 5 months of age after July 1 of the license year. These minimums may be supplemented by local municipal action. The fee for a multiple license is \$35.00 for the first 12 dogs. There is an additional fee of \$3.00 for each dog/cat over 12 dogs/cats.

PENALTIES

A late fee of \$5.00 shall be assessed the owner of each dog/cat 5 months of age or over who fails to obtain a dog/cat license by April 1, 2018.

An owner who fails to have a dog/cat vaccinated against rabies as required by ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00. 2018 dog/cat licenses must be obtained from the Village of Gresham Treasurer.
