

April 7, 2020 Presidential Preference Vote and Spring Election **VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT** Absentee ballot requests for the

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued. consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 10

You must make a request for an absentee ballot in writing or online at MyVote.wi.gov

MyVote.wi.gov. make application to your municipal clerk for an absentee ballot in person, by mail, by fax, by email or at you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. ballot online at MyVote wi.gov. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where or election or both. You may also submit a written request in the form of a letter or you may apply for an absentee Contact your municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary

Voting an absentee ballot by mail

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is: 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 2, 2020.

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

Voting an absentee ballot in person

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on April 7, 2020. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
